 later than March 9. Please make sure you do not tear the Master Sheet apart. We need
 both the white and yellow copies! Do not turn in the brochure. Save that to help you
 deliver the candy.
- Please check your order right away. Deliver the candy to your customers before Easter.
 If there is any problem with your delivered order, let us know by Friday, March 31, 2023.


Prizes for ECCSS Gardner's Candy Sale

INDIVIDUAL PRIZE: Any student who sells \$40.00 worth of candy will receive a



free piece of Gardner's candy. There is a free candy prize sheet stapled to your brochure. Just fill it out and hand it in. (Only one per student!) Make sure you put your name and homeroom on the orange prize sheet. If you do not want this incentive prize, please check the box that states, "No, thanks!"

GRADE-LEVEL PRIZE: The top five sellers in each grade will be invited to a party



in the month of April. Students in grades k-5 will have an ice cream party. Students in grades 6-12 will have a pizza party and may bring a guest. Any student who sells \$500 or more will automatically be invited to the party.

Note - This is different from previous years. Prizes are by grade level and not homeroom. High sellers are chosen from all weeks of the sale, not individual weeks.

SCHOOLWIDE GOAL: If the students in both schools, bring in a combined total sale in excess of \$30,000, there will be a drawing for one \$100.00 gift card for each building! Fill in the orange form with your name and grade level with your \$40.00 order to be eligible for the drawing.
