Dear Parent/Guardian,

As you are aware, our children are growing up in a society where drug use is becoming more and more a threat to their health and development. Unfortunately, drug abuse can affect any child, even those of well-intentioned and involved parents. We want to make you aware of a unique experience for your 6th grade child. The Saint Marys Area Middle School, Elk County Catholic School System, and various members of our community have partnered with Candle Inc. to offer a drug awareness / prevention program called **The Reality Tour.**

The Reality Tour is an evidence-based program used in hundreds of locations nationally. The program exposes students and parents to the growing threats related to drug use and abuse. The session you attend at the Saint Marys Area Middle School will consist of student acted dramatic scenes that include a drug arrest, a prison experience, emergency room scene, and a funeral scene. Actors from the Saint Marys Area High School will work with Saint Marys Chief of Police Tom Nicklas, Ambulance Service paramedics, and funeral director Lou Radkowski to present these dramatic scenes. Students are then shown a drug prevention DVD and speaker presentations. Next, local law enforcement will give a presentation to students about their experiences with our local drug challenges. Finally, the night will end with a personal story of a local recovering addict. Students and parents will have the opportunity to ask questions at any point of the program.

Your child's attendance is not mandatory but is encouraged. Because we have worked to secure grants and local contributions, there is no cost to participants. In addition, your child will receive a homework pass for the night of their attendance. Research has shown that when parents are involved, drug prevention education is far more effective. For this reason, your child MUST be accompanied by a parent or guardian. More information will be sent home with your child soon. You will have a choice of two dates, March 22nd or March 23rd.
